

## **Looking Back:**

Here is a review of what we covered this month in youth group.

- **10/2** We talked about how to understand and read the Creation Account in Genesis. Although Genesis contains some poetic elements, it was written as historical narrative. We learned how to understand the main message that God is trying to teach us, even if we still have questions about some of the details.
- **10/9** Our sixth and seventh grade students prayed over our International Workers and wrote them letters of encouragement. Our eighth through twelfth graders studied Revelation 3-4.
- **10/16** We looked at three major world religions (Buddhism, Hinduism, and Islam) and compared them to Christianity. We learned that each of these religions ultimately teaches that we have to save ourselves, and/or that we have to work our way up to God. Christianity contrastingly teaches the Good New that God came down to Earth to save us. We also learned that there is only one true God; The gods of other religions are man-made. All authority and power belong to Yahweh.
- **10/23** We reviewed the Gospel message and encouraged some of our students to practice sharing that Good News as if they were speaking with an unbeliever.
- **10/30** Time spent in intentional fellowship with one another.
